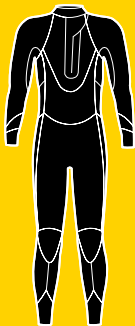
patagonia wetsuit care

Patagonia wetsuits are made with ultra-premium fabrics and trims to achieve their remarkable softness, warmth and flexibility. Proper care will maximize their life expectancy. We recommend that you:

- Avoid taking off your wetsuit while standing on hard or rough surfaces. Instead, use a bucket or lay down a towel.
- Rings and fingernails can damage the outer fabric. Please use caution.
- Rinse your wetsuit with fresh water and hang-dry it inside out.
- Hand wash with mild non-detergent soap as needed.
- Never use a washing machine, dryer, drycleaner or bleach.
- Do not dry or store in direct sun.
- Avoid folding to prevent creases.

Following these tips will prevent premature wear, helping to maintain the life of your wetsuit for years to come.

P.S. Please save the box and packing tubes that came with your suit. They are specially made to prevent wrinkles during shipping. If you return your wetsuit without the box and tubes, we will not be able to resell it after making your exchange.



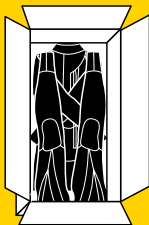
